Signing On: Sign on and Numbers at Event HQ (Ripley Scout Hall)
Please allow 5 minutes from HQ to START

Safety Instructions

CTT regulations require compulsory use of helmets for the under 18's. In the interests of your own safety, Cycling Time Trials and the event promoters strongly advise all competitors to wear a hard/soft shell helmet that meets an internationally accepted safety standard.

Competitors Machines: It is recommended that a working, rear light, either flashing or constant, is fitted to the machine in a position clearly visible to following road users and is active while the machine is in use.

Competitors are requested not to warm up on the course after the first competitor has started. Details of any additional hazards not listed on the start sheet will be displayed at the signing on point. All competitors must read these details when they sign on. Competitors must exercise extra care when turning LEFT on to the A246, at West Horsley roundabout and when passing the Start Point at the end of the first circuit. Also competitors crossing the central line of Rose Lane prior to turning left into Hungry Hill Lane may be disqualified.

No times will be given at the finish.

General Notes:

London South District Regulation: No vehicles shall be parked on the highway within sight of the starting or finishing points.

Specific to Event:

Due to the large number of novice riders in this event with no prior times to assist with seeding, riders attention is drawn to the regulations that govern Time Trials and prohibits drafting (riding in company).

Please be aware of new parking restrictions in side roads off Rose Lane (near Scout Hut). There is a new car park WITH HEIGHT BARRIER. Those with roof mounted bikes please be aware.

PLEASE KEEP NOISE TO MINIMUM FOR RESIDENTS AND RESPECT PARKING RESTRICTIONS.

Gil Jessop:

The Kingston Wheelers Cycling Club was formed in 1924. Six cyclists met in a cafe on the Portsmouth Road near Kingston police station. Gil Jessop, for whom this race is a memorial, joined the club in about 1930. The second world war curtailed activities for a number of years. The last club run was in 1941 and most members were called up for service. Gil Jessop served in the armed forces and after demob, he helped to reform the club in Chessington in 1953. He later became President of the club until his death in the early 1990s.
