

CLUB RULES

1. This Club shall be called the Kingston Wheelers Cycling Club ("the Club") and shall be affiliated to the British Cycling Federation, Cycling Time Trials, The Cyclist's Touring Club and other such local or national associations as from time to time the Management Committee shall see fit.
2. The management of the Club shall be by a Management Committee ("the Management Committee") consisting of the Club Officials plus up to five Committee Members, all to be elected annually.
3. The Club Officials shall be: President, Chairman, General Secretary, Treasurer and other such Secretaries (Time Trial Secretary, Road Racing Secretary, Social Secretary and Press Secretary), as the activities of the Club may require.
4. First Claim members only shall be eligible as Club Officials.
5. Club's colours shall be Kingfisher Blue and Navy Blue.
6. Membership will begin on the date of the Club receiving the appropriate membership application and will expire 12 months after this date
7. The annual subscription for full First Claim members shall be £30 per 12 month period.
8. The annual subscription for Second Claim members shall be £10.00 per 12 month period.
9. The annual subscription for Junior, Student and unwaged First Claim members shall be £10.00 per 12 month period.
10. The annual subscription amount will be reviewed annually
11. Members desirous of resigning shall notify the General Secretary.
12. Every individual wanting to become a member shall complete an application form and submit this with the appropriate subscription as outlined above.
13. Any member not paying his subscription within one month after the expiry of their membership period shall be deemed to have resigned.
14. The Management Committee shall meet every six weeks on dates to be agreed to transact the Club's business, five to form a quorum. Any member of the Committee absent from three consecutive meetings without affording reasonable explanation and obtaining leave of absence may, at the discretion of the Committee, be deemed to have resigned, and the Committee may fill the vacancy.
15. Members shall be liable to disciplinary action for conduct prejudicial to the interests of the Club and/or the Sport. The Management Committee shall have disciplinary powers and may, in serious cases, expel members from the Club.
16. No member shall be allowed to take part in any Club event or ride in the Club name unless all his financial obligations to the Club have been paid.
17. The Club's financial year shall commence on 1 January and end on 31 December after which date the Treasurer shall prepare the Balance Sheet and subsidiary accounts, which shall be audited by two Auditors elected at the previous Annual General Meeting. The Audited Accounts shall be presented at the Annual General Meeting.
18. The Management Committee shall be entitled to enter into such sponsorship or other agreements as it believes are in the interest of the Club. Subject to any such proposal having been approved at a Management Committee meeting.
19. The Annual General Meeting shall be held in early February, and at least fourteen days' notice of such meeting shall be sent to the members enclosing a copy of the Agenda.
20. Items for the Agenda of any General Meeting shall reach the General Secretary at least 21 days before the relevant meeting.
21. A Special General Meeting may be called by the Management Committee or, alternatively, by the General Secretary, upon receipt of a request signed by seven members with a copy of the Agenda attached, subject to at least fourteen day's notice being given to the members.
22. No alteration in, or addition to, these Rules shall be made except with the consent of at least two-thirds of the members present at the Annual General Meeting or Special General Meeting called for the purpose, notice thereof to be circulated to the members fourteen days before the meeting, together with a copy of the Agenda, or copy of the relevant alteration or addition proposed.
23. Any matter not provided in these Rules shall be dealt with by the Management Committee, whose decision shall be binding on all parties.
